Through Lucy, the event attracted various stakeholders from the community i.e. the community health workers (5), the Kiengu market leadership (5) the local administration (1), in addition to the girls (25) and their parents (25).

3 IAF volunteers joined the women group in Meru. Among them were Martin, Njeri and Doreen all from Nairobi.

Thanks to the IAF members' generous contribution and the Chapter Development fund, the team was able to share with the girls living with disability 107 packets of sanitary pads. In addition to the 25 dignity packs Lucy had mobilized for them.

As we shared the power of Facilitation, Martin used songs as a tool to educate the girls while Njeri demonstrated how to use the sanitary kit. Lucy did the game of life as a facilitation tool to inclusion for persons living with disability. The event was highly participatory, interesting and elicited lots of conversations of issues that are rarely spoken about.
